The water can be used to wash the hands before it is being collected to fill the water tank for the next flush.

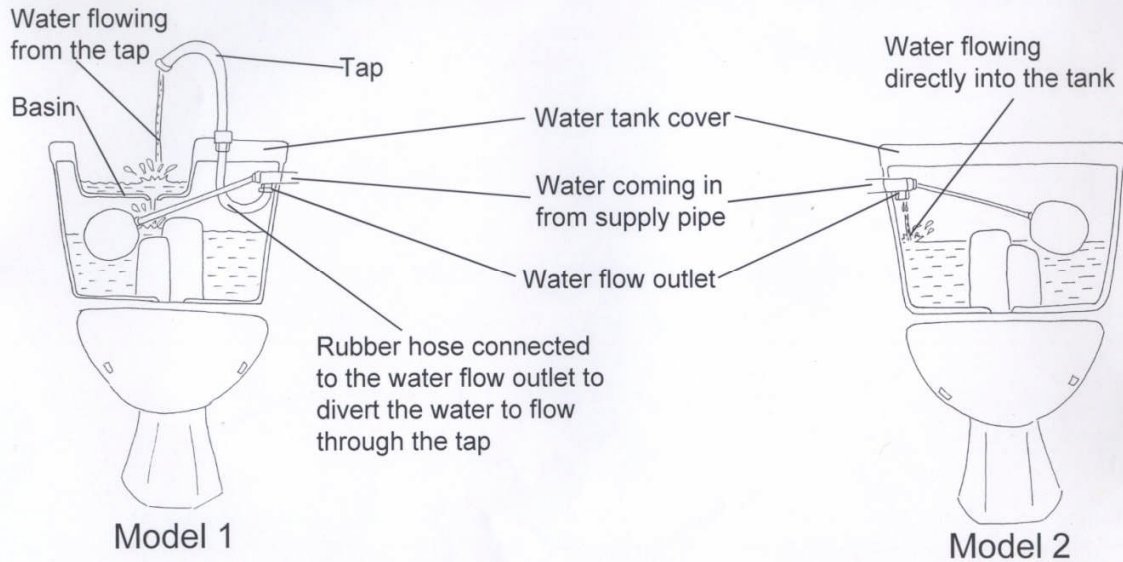

FLUSH ' N' WASH water closet vs **CONVENTIONAL** model



With Model 1, the water is diverted to flow from the tap using a simple rubber hose, where else in Model 2, the water will be flowing directly into the water tank. As in both models, the water supply will automatically stop as soon as the tank is full.



SAVE SO MUCH WATER -

The water which is used to wash the hands is used again to flush the toilet bowl.

SO CONVENIENT -

Water will automatically start flowing from the tap as soon as the toilet bowl is flushed and will stop when the water tank is full. No need to install a separate hand washer in the toilet.

MORE HYGIENIC TOO -

No need to touch a dirty tap before and after washing the hands.

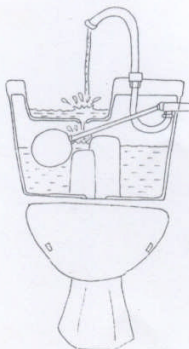

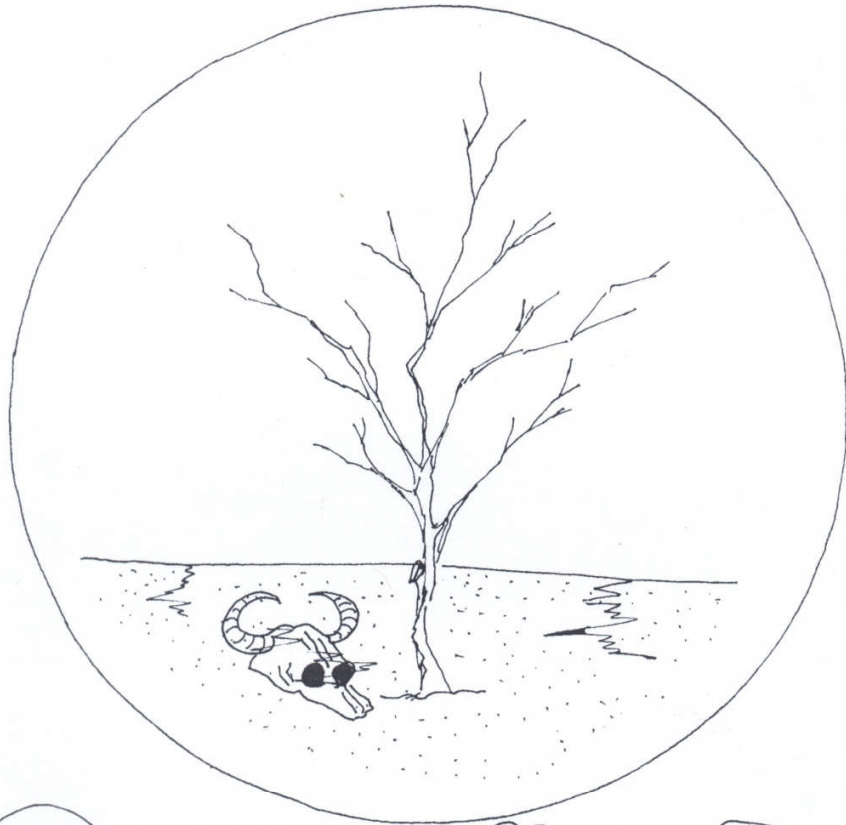

WHY ?

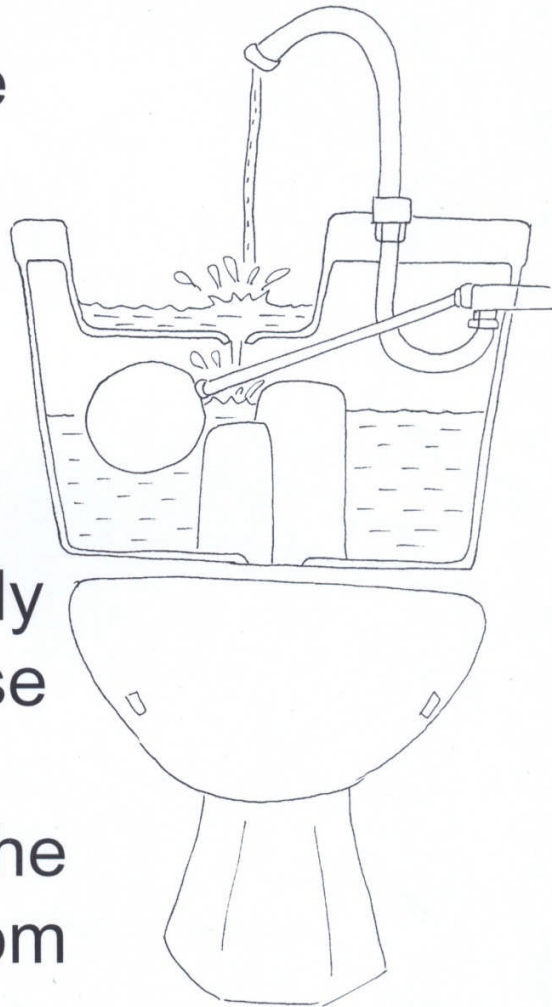
So that the water can be used to wash the hands before it is allowed to fill up the tank.

WHEN ?

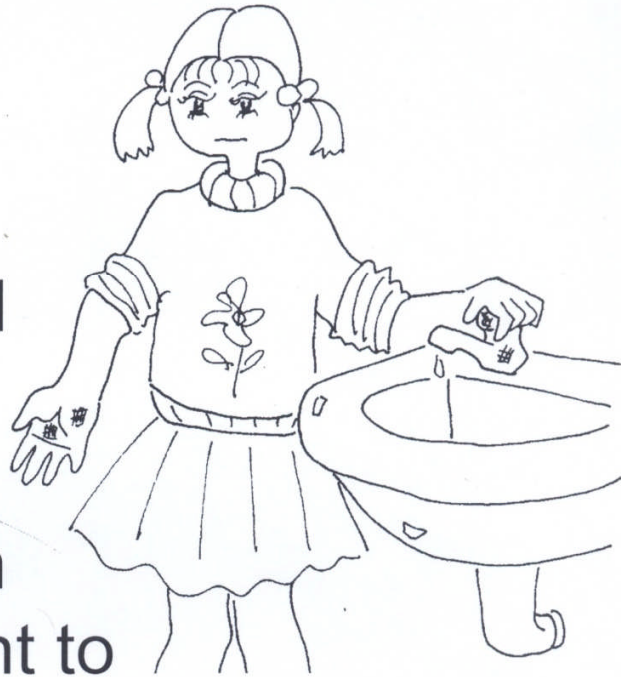
When you want to wash your hands, after using the toilet,
